1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "Authorization for Use
5 of Military Force against International Terrorism Act".
6 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF ARMED FORCES.

(a) IN GENERAL.—The President is authorized, with

the close consultation, coordination, and cooperation with

NATO and regional allies, to use all necessary and appro-

priate force against those countries, organizations, or persons associated with or supporting terrorist groups, including al Qaeda and its regional affiliates, the Islamic 3 4 State of Iraq and Syria, al Shabaab, Boko Haram, and 5 any other emerging regional terrorist groups that share 6 a common violent extremist ideology with such terrorist groups, regional affiliates, or emerging terrorist groups, 8 in order to eliminate all such terrorist groups and prevent any future acts of international terrorism against the United States or its allies by such terrorist groups, coun-10 tries, organizations, or persons. 12 (b) War Powers Resolution Requirements.— 13 (1) Specific statutory authorization.— 14 Consistent with section 8(a)(1) of the War Powers 15 Resolution, Congress declares that this section is in-16 tended to constitute specific statutory authorization 17 within the meaning of section 5(b) of the War Pow-18 ers Resolution. 19 (2)APPLICABILITY OF OTHER REQUIRE-20 MENTS.—Nothing in this Act supercedes any re-21 quirement of the War Powers Resolution.
