Appeals having been taken to this Court from an order of the Supreme Court,
New York County, entered on or about September 27, 2023 (Case No. 2023-04925),

from an order of the same Court entered on or about February 16, 2024 (Case No. 2024-01134) and from a judgment of the same Court entered on or about February 23, 2024 (Case No. 2024-01135),

And plaintiff-respondent having moved for an order dismissing defendants-appellants' appeal taken under Case No. 2023-04925, or, in the alternative, requiring consolidated briefing for that appeal and defendants-appellants' appeals taken under Case Nos. 2024-01134 and 2024-01135,

Now, upon reading and filing the papers with respect to the motion, and due deliberation having been had thereon,

It is ordered that, to the extent the motion seeks dismissal of defendants-appellants' appeal taken under Case No. 2023-04925, such relief is denied, without prejudice to addressing the issue directly on appeal, and

It is further ordered that the alternative request for consolidation is granted, to the extent that the appeals filed under Case No. 2023-04925, and each of the appeals filed under Case Nos. 2024-01134 and 2024-01135 shall be perfected together pursuant to 22 NYCRR 1250.9(f), upon a single record and set of briefs, to be filed in accordance with the dates set forth by the interim order of a Justice of this Court entered on June 17, 2024.
